Event Format:

Round 1:

Objective:

In this round, participating teams will engage in an online quiz hosted on Unstop.

Task:

Teams will be tested on their data science knowledge, analytical skills, and problem-solving abilities.

Result:

The top 8 scoring teams from Round 1 will advance to the final round.

Round 2:

Objective:

The top 8 teams from Round 1 will compete in this final showdown.

Task:

Teams will receive a new, challenging problem statement and dataset. Presentation: Each team will have a maximum of 6 minutes to present their solution and insights to the judges.

Result:

The group that shows the most innovation, the best report and presentation quality, and the best Q&A session based on the submitted report and presentation will win the Data Detective Challenge.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Team Composition:

- Each team can consist of a maximum of 4 members and a minimum of 1 member.
- No team member can simultaneously participate in multiple

teams. Violation of this rule will result in the disqualification of both teams.

- Each team must designate one member as the team captain.

2. Plagiarism:

- Any form of plagiarism is strongly discouraged. Teams found engaging in plagiarism will face immediate elimination.

3. Tool Usage:

- Teams are encouraged to use any data visualization and data analytical tools of their choice.

4. Presentation:

- Teams must make a presentation lasting no more than 6 minutes to showcase their solution and insights to the judges.

5. Submission Requirements:

- In addition to the presentation, teams are required to submit a PDF document before the event. This document should not exceed 10 pages and should provide an in-depth evaluation of the team's findings.

Judging Criteria:

- **Questions and Answers Session:** Each team will face a maximum of 4 minutes of questions from the judges after their presentation.
- **Scoring:** Teams will be evaluated based on their creativity, presentation quality, and the feasibility of their business proposal.
- **Final Decision:** The final decision will be made by the Technical Team of Wissenaire under all circumstances.
